Russell Wood, CEO provided an overview of the finalized District 6 Plan Priorities which used both quantitative and qualitative data and input from Providers in the District to identify district gaps. The group reviewed the District 6 Disability Access Point District Assessment, with the priority focus on developing information sharing and navigation hub, and legislative outreach and funding advocacy. Addition of hiring a Disability Access Point Project Manager in each District to lead community support and outreach efforts and engage with providers was discussed. Next steps and the role of the Advisory Council in developing a district-wide navigation workflow and referral guide were reviewed with a goal of March 31, 2026 with several members expressing interest in volunteering time. Participating in legislative roundtables and provider forum development was explored. The group discussed the importance of collaboration and communication between different organizations, emphasizing the need for flexible funding and common messaging. Next steps included identifying potential network members and preparing for the arrival of a project manager who would reach out to participants for further input.
